

Haverford Hawks' COVID-19 Guidelines

Club Requirements

- All players, coaches, volunteers and spectators must complete the [COVID Questionnaire](#) for all Hawks' practices and games
- All players, coaches and spectators are required to wear masks. Masks are not required for players when on the ice.
- All managers must take and record player and coach temperatures upon entry for practices or home games.
- Team managers will share guidelines with visiting teams so ensure requirements are met.

Atlantic Amateur Hockey Association (AAHA) Guidelines

- All players, coaches, volunteers and spectators **must wear face coverings** in rinks, unless exempt under the Pennsylvania Department of Health guidelines

Skatium Guidelines

- Player may dress in lobby area; locker rooms remain closed.
- No restriction on number of spectators; anyone under 18 must be accompanied by guardian.
- Spectators are required to remain in the stands; standing by glass and congregating in common areas is prohibited.

Springfield Guidelines

- **Enter** via front doors; **Exit** via two emergency exit doors (by the bleachers).
- Locker rooms open and may be used at player's discretion.
- Players may enter 15 minutes prior to start time and must leave within 15 minutes after ice slot.
- Maximum of 1 spectator per player.
- Sit in designated seating areas only.

Away Games: Team Managers will communicate host rink guidelines. All Hawks' teams will respect and abide by those guidelines in addition to Hawks' and AAHA's guidelines.
